A WAY TO GIVE! For many who have embraced online banking in the information age, regular check writing is a thing of the past. Some of you have asked about online giving for the church. At present, the church does not offer this option. Online financial processing involves a fee per transaction, so there would be a cost to the church. There is a solution that might work for some of you.

Many banks offer a **free Bill Pay** service to customers. Through your financial institution, you set up the amount you want to give and the frequency, and the bank will issue the check directly to the church. That way, you would not need to write a check and remember to bring it with you to church.
