▶ **Seeker's Class**, led by Sam Haase and Mike Zobrist, will begin the study of II Corinthians.

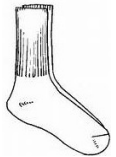
▶ **Walking in Faith**, led by Lilian Hahn, Marion Forbes and Virginia Holloway, will begin a study of II Corinthians.
