RESPOND TO GOD'S WORD

*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH: In the presence of Jesus, who lived out what God wants us all to be, we were threatened beyond endurance. Blinded by our rebellion against our Creator, we killed his Son when we met him face to face. We believe that in the death of Jesus on the cross, God achieved and demonstrated, once for all, the costly forgiveness of our sins. Jesus Christ is the Reconciler between God and the world. He acted on behalf of sinners as one of us, fulfilling the obedience God demands of us, accepting God's condemnation of our sinfulness. In his lonely agony on the cross, Jesus felt forsaken by God and thus experienced hell itself for us. Yet, the Son was never more in accord with the Father's will. He was acting on behalf of God, manifesting the Father's love, that takes on itself the loneliness, pain, and death that results from our waywardness. In Christ, God was reconciling the world to the Divine self, not holding our sins against us. Each of us beholds on the cross, the Savior, who died in our place, so that we may no longer live for ourselves, but for him.
